

DORMITORY ROOMS

Dormitory rooms are at Forbes College or the Princeton Theological Seminary. A refundable deposit of \$50 will be required at registration for each dormitory room key and a \$50 deposit for linens (total \$100). Checkout time at the Registration Desk is from 8:00 AM to 10:00 AM on Sunday morning, at which time deposits will be returned. To facilitate check-in, deposits should be by check, no cash.

HEADQUARTERS AND REGISTRATION

The Headquarters and Registration area will be in the lobby of Forbes College. The headquarters will be staffed during the following hours:

PARKING

CAMPUS SHUTTLE

The shuttle service has a stop at Forbes College and provides transportation to the parking lots and various locations on campus. See the Reunion Booklet for times of service.

Beer and wine service will **ONLY** be available during the hours listed above under Registration (excluding Sunday). Note there is no service between 1 and 5 PM on Saturday at the request of the University.

Please abide by the alcoholic beverage restrictions by wearing your wristbands at all times. Wristbands are only issued by University representatives. If lost, they cost \$75 to replace unless you have the parts from the old band.

Beer, wine and soda are provided at no charge. If you wish to consume other alcoholic beverages, you may bring your own and store them at the bar where ID tags will be provided. Bottles will be stored overnight. No individual drinks will be sold.

MEALS

Some meals require tickets which should be in your registration envelope. These are Friday Dinner, Saturday Lunch, Saturday Dinner, and Sunday Brunch.
